It's a Center of New York City Government that has seen the progression of American history since 1812. Constructed between 1803 and 1812 by architects John McComb., and Joseph Francois Mangin, City Hall is considered a fine example of American architecture with French Renaissance influence. Upstairs are the City Council chambers and the Governor's Room, which houses a desk that George Washington used and portraits of historical New York leaders.
